WASHINTON STATE PAID FAMILY & MEDICAL LEAVE ACT (PFMLA): Doug Lash with McKenzie Rothwell Barlow & Coughran P.S. will be here to answer questions and go over important points regarding Washington's new Paid Family & Medical Leave Act that begins accruing on January 1, 2019. The PFMLA establishes a state insurance pool for short-term family and medical leave. Starting on January 1, 2019, employers must begin reporting employee wages and hours and remitting premiums to the state. Benefits will first be available as of January 1, 2020. This benefit generally overlaps and runs together with the federal FMLA.
