Project Interview Presentation Skills

At some point in your career as an electrical project manager, your company may appoint you to complete an interview and presentation during the RFP (request for proposal) process. *Interview and Presentation Skills* discusses how electrical project managers hone their interview and presentation skills as a competitive edge during the RFP process.

Following this course, you will be able to:

- · Discuss the importance of knowing your audience
- · Actively listen to the responses from your audience
- · Discuss the importance of being prepared
- · Discuss the importance of being concise
- · Create and follow an agenda
- · Be prepared to go off script, if necessary, based on questions
- · Discuss the importance of non-verbal communication (body language, tone, when you speak)
- · Identify the importance of careful proofreading
- · Carefully label and answer every question in the RFP

It is recommended that participants take Communication Best Practices prior to this course.
